Children should have heard of some famous artist that are mentioned in this unit.

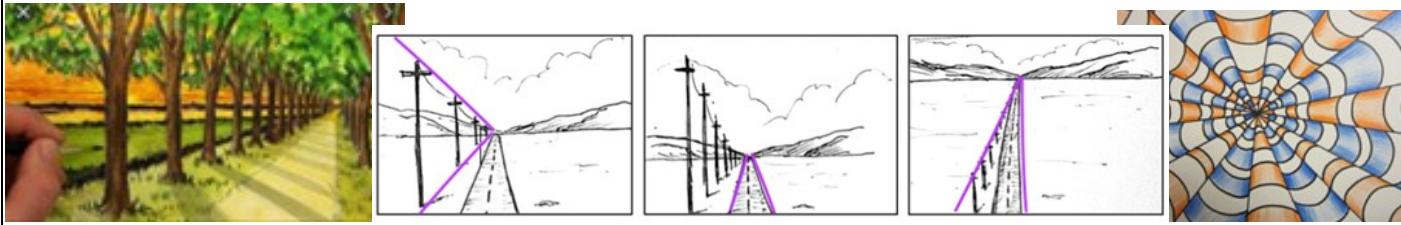
What will I know by the end of this unit?

To discuss my artwork with others and say that I think about it.

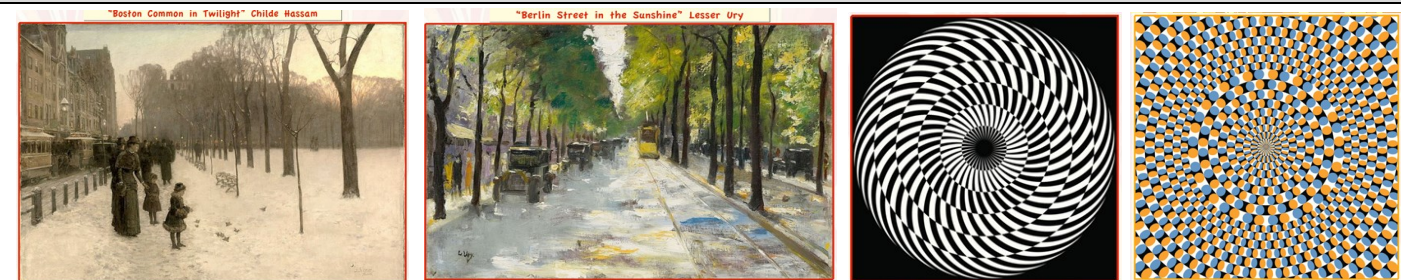
Vocabulary:

Illusion	When a person is tricked and therefore, makes a wrong interpretation of something.
Perspective	Art that represents 3-D objects with the right height, width, depth and position on a 2-D surface.
Vanishing Point	The where a set of straight lines meet to help make a perspective clear.
Horizon Line	The line in the far distance where the sky appears to meet the land/sea.
Construction Line	Faint lines drawn to guide and help an artist create the correct perspective.
Depth	The distance from the top to the bottom of something.
Foreshortening	Making something look closer than it really is.
Trompe l'oeil	A technique which means 'to deceive the eye'. When an artist uses clever techniques to make a painting look a particular way.
Photorealism	A type of art that focuses on a photograph which is then reproduced using different art mediums,
Optical	An illusion that causes tricks on the viewer's eyes.
