Andy Goldsworthy is a British sculptor, photographer and environmentalist. He lives in Scotland. He has made his sculptures in forests, farms, fields, cities, mountains and more. Sometimes they last for a long time, other times they last only days.
He uses: leaves, bark, sticks, mud, flowers, stones, feathers, sand, light, reflections and shadows. He often makes spirals, circles, swirls and arches.

Land Art - Land Art is made in the landscape using natural materials from the environment.
Sculpture - 3D Art
Sculptor - An artist that produces Sculptures.
Rain Shadow - The outline left behind when rain falls on a person or object laid on the floor or other surface .
Andy Goldsworthy - Famous land artist.
Abstract - Not a real representation but uses shapes, colours and patterns.
Natural - From nature.
Ephemera - I Does not last forever.
Man-made - Not from nature, made by humans.
