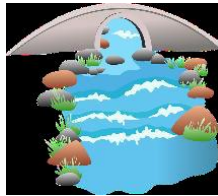
Strand: Where do I live?

Important facts

Blackburn is a town in England.

Vocabulary

Town – Is a place with many streets, where people live and work.

Country – An area of land that has its own government. (a group of people who makes rules for the people who live in the country.)

Settlement – Is a place where people have come to live and have built homes.

Locality – Is a small area of a country or city.

River- Is a large amount of fresh water flowing continuously in a long line across the land.

Detached house – A house that is not joined to another house.

Semi-detached house – A house that is joined to another house on one side by their walls.

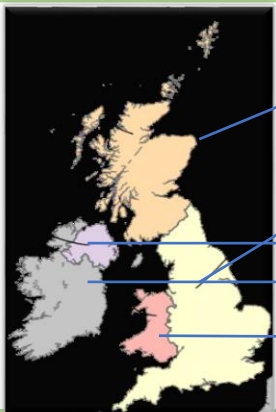
Terraced house –Is one of a row of houses joined together by their side walls.

Bungalow – Is a house which has only one level, and no stairs.

Flat - is a set of rooms for living in, usually on one floor and part of a larger building.
