Important facts

Aboriginal art is based on stories and these are portrayed within the artwork, often including animals.
Aboriginal artwork uses the technique of cross hatching.
Painting can be done using a dotting technique as seen in aboriginal artwork.

Skills

To be able to use a range of materials creatively to design and make a product.

Vocabulary

Cross hatching – using criss-crossed lines to build up light and dark areas.

Line - can be straight, curved, horizontal, vertical, diagonal and can change direction.

Symbol – a mark used to represent an object or movement.

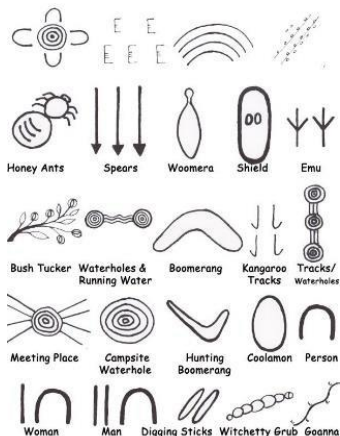
Texture – using lines and shadow to create an illusion of what it would feel like.

Aborigines – the first people to live in Australia (indigenous people).

Dreamtime – stories about how the world, plants and animals were made.

Boomerang - Used for hunting.

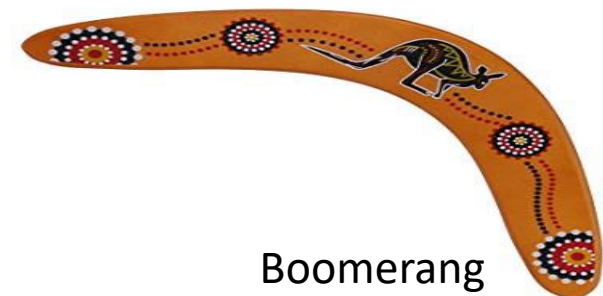
