Vocab

Capital city – the city where the government sits

Climate – weather that is typical for that place

Continent – A very large area of land that consists of many countries

Country – an area of land controlled by the government

Human Features – features of land that have been impacted by human activity

Physical Features – natural features of land.

Humid – A damp and hot climate

Landscape – everything you can see when you look across a land area including, hills, rivers, buildings, trees and plants

Vocab

Seasons - main periods of the year that can have their own weather conditions.

Skyscrapers – very tall building with many floors

Tourist – a person who is visiting a place for pleasure or interest.

Town – A large group of houses, shops, buildings where people live and work

Vegetation – plants, trees, flowers

Village - a small groups of house, perhaps some shops
