

EYFS CURRICULUM OVERVIEW - AUTUMN 2

English/RWInc

This half term we will be reading a variety of traditional tales including:

- The three Little Pigs
- The Three Billy Goats Gruff
- Goldilocks and the Three Bears
- The Gingerbread man.

We will also read the Jolly Christmas Postman and The Nativity.

Our writing opportunities will be based around these texts.

Read, Writ Inc – this half term we will continue to set 1 sounds and start to blend with them.

Understanding of the World

This half term our topic is Story Teller.

Within this unit we look at:

- Identify, observe and draw different kinds of animals and their body parts.
- How to keep ourselves safe for Bonfire night.
- Remembrance Day
- Christmas now and in the past.
- Christmas around the world

Reading

Please read with you child for 5 minutes each day. It will make such a difference in how quickly they will improve.

In a few weeks your child may start bring home books with words.

Please help them by sounding out the sounds and blending. Sat = s a t sat

Christmas

At the end of term the children will be performing a Christmas Nativity for you. In a few weeks we will be sending home any lines your child may need to learn. Please practice these with them.

Expressive Arts

This half term we will:

- investigate which materials – make houses for the 3 little pigs
- make gingerbread biscuits
- large bridge build
- role play tradition tales
- Christmas crafts as part of Christmas Art Day

In music we be learning our Nativity songs.

Physical Development

This half term the children will continue with fundamental skill:

- Balancing
- Throwing/catching a ball
- Jump and land
- Climb over and through
- Over arm throw
