

EYFS CURRICULUM OVERVIEW – SUMMER 2

English/RWInc

This half term we will be reading a variety of stories including:

- Pirates love underpants
- Puff the Magic Dragon
- Winnie the Witch
- The Knight that said no
- Once upon a mermaid
- Freddie and the Fairy

Our writing opportunities will be based around these texts.

Read, Writ Inc – this half term we will continue to blend with set 1 sounds including special friends. m, a, s, d, t, l, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, sh, ch, th, ng, nk

Some children will begin to learn set 2 sounds: ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo,

Religious Education

During RE This half term we will look at:

Within Personal Social Emotional Development this half term we will be looking at Being my Best.

Maths

This half term the children will be learning:

- Money
- Shape, Sorting and Pattern
- Multiplication and Division
- Space
- Time
- Addition and Subtraction

Understanding of the World

This half term our topic is Storyland – focusing on Fantasy and Adventure.

We will learn how to :

- Identify objects that float and sink
- Think about how different environments vary
- Identify adult and baby animals
- Plan and draw maps
- Understand why shadows form

At the end of term we will be having a special assembly which will be followed by a gallery showing of the children's self-portraits they have done over the year. We hope you can all make it, on Wednesday 9th July at 9am.

Reading

Each week your child will bring home a reading book. These will be ditty sheets or 'word' books when your child is blending.

This needs to be returned on a Monday and sent back on a Wednesday – please sign the reading record to show it has been read – or it will not be changed.

Please spend 5 minutes each night 'reading' with your child.

Expressive Arts

This half term we will be learning to:

- Make and print parrots
- Bake biscuits
- Make a cauldron - paper mâché
- Create mermaid pictures
- Thread to create a mermaid tale

In music we be learning to :

- Recognise the structure of a song
- Create movement to a sequence
- Perform a song and dance to an audience

Physical Development

This half term the children will be completing a 'At The Seaside' topic in PE.

We will learn:

- A gymnastic crab walk.
- Travel around the space like a crab to music.
- Make various shapes linked to the animals they would see at the seaside
- Practice skills for sports day
