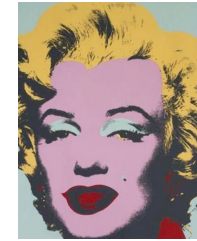


Art- Andy Warhol

Vocabulary

Definition

Andy Warhol	An American artist who was one of the most important artists in the Pop art movement.
Artist	A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby.
Blotted line technique	Make a line drawing on a piece of non-absorbent paper, such as tracing paper. Then go over the line in ink, blotting the marks on a piece of paper that would absorb the ink. Hinge the two pieces of paper together, blot different parts of the picture while the ink is wet.
Pop art	Drew its inspiration from popular culture.
Self-portrait	A portrait of an artist realized by the artist himself or herself, mainly through the medium of painting, drawing, sculpture or photography.
