

EYFS CURRICULUM OVERVIEW - AUTUMN 1

English/RWInc

This half term we will be reading a variety of stories including:

- Colour Monster
- Colour Monster Goes to School
- Awesome Ambulances
- Topsy and Tim meet the Police
- Charlie the Firefighter
- The Three Little Pigs
- The Leaf Thief
- Hello Autumn

Our writing opportunities will be based around these texts.

Religious Education

This half term we will be covering the topic of the Creation and Covenant. We will learn:

- That God made our beautiful world and everything in it.

Within Personal Social Emotional Development this half term we will learn to:

This half term the children will be learning:

- number 1
- number 2
- number 3
- number 4
- we will also learn and sing number rhymes and songs

Understanding of the World

This half term our topic is People Who Help Us. We will learn:

- about different types of people who can help us
- how we can keep ourselves safe
- look at and draw local maps
- look at vehicles and uniforms from past and present for the emergency services
- Seasonal changes - Autumn

We will also look at how to look after our oral health. We have organised a visit by a policewoman and a paramedic.

Reading

From the week beginning 28th September the children will be bringing home a picture book to share with you. This needs to be returned on the given day which will be in their bag for us to change.

As your child begins to blend they will start to bring home books matched to their sound focus. Please spend 5 minutes each night 'reading' with your child.

Expressive Arts

This half term we will be learning to:

- Use collage materials
- Create self-portraits using paint
- Create art based on music
- Use chalk to create fire pictures
- Junk model vehicles
- Printing
- Autumn Leaves

In music we be learning:

- nursery rhymes
- finding the rhythm and pulse.

Physical Development

This half term the children will be focusing on their fundamental motor skills.

- running
- travelling
- balancing
- spatial awareness.

Our PE day is Friday, please ensure your child comes into school wearing their PE kit. They may wear **black** leggings or jogging bottoms to keep them warm.
