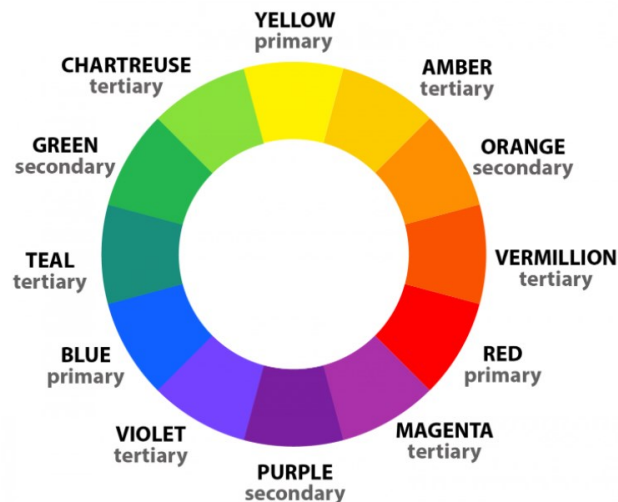

Vocabulary:

Pointillism	when a series of small dots are used to create a picture.
George Seurat	The artist that invented pointillism art.
impressionist	A type of painter.
method	How to create something following a series of instructions.
La Grande Jatte	George Seurat's most famous painting.
Pure colour	A single colour.
Variety of media	A variety of art equipment e.g. felt tips, paint, oil pastels.
artist	The person who created the piece of artwork.
Primary colours	Red, green and blue.
Secondary colours	A secondary colour is a colour made by mixing of two primary colours in a given colour space e.g. green, orange, purple.
Tertiary colours	The combination of primary and secondary colors is known as tertiary or intermediate colors, due to their compound nature. Blue-green, blue-violet, red-orange, red-violet, yellow-orange, and yellow-green are color combinations you can make from color mixing.
