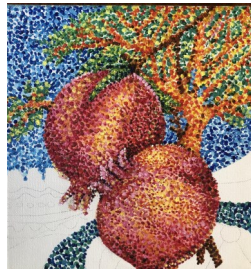
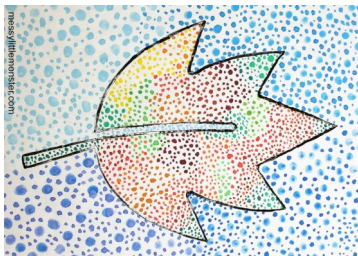
Seurat and Pointillism

Vocabulary

Definition

Neo-Impressionism

Artwork that is characterised by the use of the divisionist technique.

Pointillism

An Impressionist painting technique developed by Georges Seurat, based on colour theory and the use of complementary colours in particular.

Optical Mixing

The perception of color resulting from the combination of adjacent colours.

Shading

The darkening or colouring of a drawing with lines or blocks of colour.
